

My Data Collection Plan for the ELS

Make a plan! Identify specific times of the day during which you will collect data for each item on the ELS. For example, at the start of the day you can observe how children move through routines for evidence on the Self-regulation item. Also, at the water table you may choose to use the Scientific Inquiry item or Measurement strand to guide your interactions. A sample is listed below for your reference.
